What to expect from 2024 GIPF meeting

The 11th National Congress of the Italian Group of Forensic Pathology (GIPF) will be held in Rome, at the University Cattolica del Sacro Cuore. The Italian Forensic Pathology is on its way forward internationalization, combining tradition with and bold innovation, pursuing quality and multidisciplinary. On opening the Congress we will discuss the current role of the forensic pathologist in US and EU, along with an overview of national trends in pushing technical and authorization procedures. Forensic investigation of international crime victims will be addressed, focusing on multidisciplinary practical approach and on the experience of the Public Prosecutor's Office in specific forensic contexts like terrorist attacks' casualties and war crimes. On April 19th, the morning session will be dedicated to the issue of prioritizing quality in a field that sometimes risks being driven by quantity and by low standards. The value of scientific evidence will be discussed in the light of the viewpoint of Italian Supreme Court, while experts will analyze what direction Criminal Law and Forensic Pathology are heading in. Choosing quality over quantity is also a critical scientific issue since the recent "paperdemic" and the phenomenon of the predatory publishers, that will be evaluated by the Editors of the two main scientific journals of the forensic field. Finally, quality in education and as a core item of evaluation will be addressed by experts in Legal Medicine. The afternoon session will deal with drowning. The complexity of this kind of death has urged forensic pathologists to broaden the dimension of forensic investigation beyond the exclusive autopsy, encompassing toxicological and genetic analyses and making a critical example of beneficial multidisciplinary approach of it. Multidisciplinary attitude will also lead the evening, with the round table of the Presidents of the National Groups of Forensic Pathologists, Forensic Toxicologists and Forensic Geneticists. April 20th will be dedicated to the young forensic pathologists and to their commitment to envision the future. The three best oral communications presented at the Congress will be awarded by the GIPF, concluding the event.






Terrazza Caffarelli is a panoramic rooftop and fantastic location for events on the Capitoline Hill, in the very center of Rome.
